

Product Line	Propprep								
Description	Propprep is a special cleaner and metal conditioner designed to remove grease and other contaminants and provide a chemically conditioned surface prior to painting.								
Typical Uses	As a pretreatment and cleaner for propellers, shafts, struts and rudders prior to application of the Propspeed foul release system.								
Application	Apply Propprep solution liberally by rag or wipes, working over small areas at a time. Do not allow the Propprep solution to dry out. Remove by wiping off thoroughly with a clean rag. Before applying the Propspeed Etch Primer, solvent wipe complete surface with Propclean.								
Performance & Limitations	<p>Performance Excellent chemical conditioner that cleans and conditions the metal surface.</p> <p>Limitations The surface which has been cleaned with the Propprep should be painted as soon as possible after treatment (preferably within 4 hours). Propprep should not be used on zinc, cadmium, and magnesium as these are susceptible to chemical attack by acids.</p>								
Health & Safety	<p>Propprep Propprep is acidic. Operators should wear gloves, goggles and protective clothing. If splashed onto the skin, wash off with copious amounts of soap and water. If splashed into eyes, wash and flush eye with water for minimum of 15 minutes. In case of ingestion, give patient copious quantities of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. In all cases seek medical attention promptly.
